Please practise the letters of the alphabet in cursive handwriting.

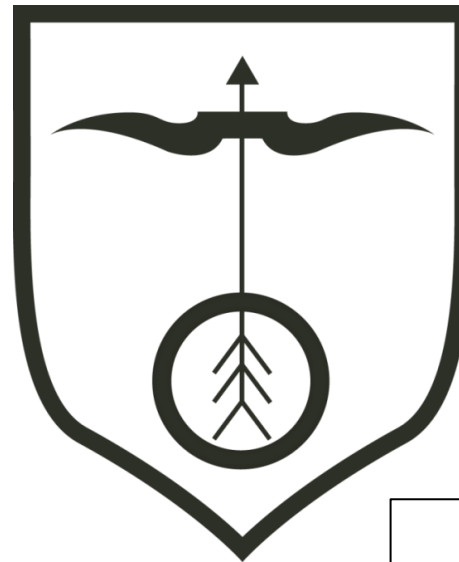
Mental Maths
