Write instructions or an advice leaflet for citizens to follow during an air raid. Make sure your advice and instructions are clear and easy to follow.

### Write a newspaper report of a bombing on your street.

Pretend you are a news reporter and create a newspaper report of a bombing on your street.

You could even include witness statements!  
(Don't forget your inverted commas!)

### Make a Anderson/ Morrison shelter

Make an air raid shelter. / Anderson shelter. Think about which materials would be best to use.

### Make a World War 2 song.

Write a song to keep people's spirits up during the war and we can learn/sing it in the classroom.
