Titanic: Home Learning Tasks

Select one homework task and hand it in or share it on Monday.

(You must choose at least two writing tasks over the course of the term)

Draw Titanic

Find a picture of Titanic and then do a detailed drawing or painting of it. You may (if you wish) choose to label the different parts.

Visit your Local library

Choose some interesting books related to Titanic. Then research and present on a subject of your choosing

Create a timeline

Design, draw and label a timeline about the Titanic. It could be about the events during the sinking or cover the different aspects of her construction.

Write a diary entry as if you were on board Titanic

Are you rich or poor? Can you describe a day and your feelings about this? It could be a normal day or the day of the sinking.

Visit the grave of Bruce Ismay

He was on Titanic – we will learn about him. He is buried in Putney Vale Cemetery (near Asda). Can you find the grave and take a photograph of it for your topic book?

Produce a model of Titanic

Make a 3D model of Titanic using paper, card or other materials. Can you add fine details and paint it the right colours?

Write a short fact file about a famous passenger

Titanic had many rich and famous passengers on board. Can you research one of the passengers and then write about them. Try to include a picture of your chosen person.

Edwardian Food

Research the sort of food that was eaten on board Titanic. Can you write a menu for one of the restaurants?

Research Edwardian Fashion

Find out about Edwardian clothing and fashion. How was it different to what the earlier Victorians wore? How did it differ if you were rich or poor?

Write a story

Write a story about someone involved in the Titanic disaster. It could be about a passenger or a member of the crew.
