DRAW

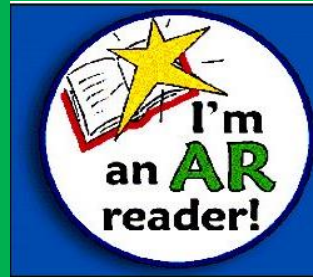
- Design your own Egyptian-style death mask. Tutankhamun's is blue and gold, but you could use any colours or patterns.
- Design your own God/Goddess. What are they worshipped for? What do they look like? Do they have any special powers?

WRITE

- Imagine you have just discovered an ancient Egyptian tomb. Write a newspaper report explaining what has been found.
- Write a secret message using hieroglyphics and see if your friends can decode it.

VISIT

- Take a trip to Howard Carter's grave. The archaeologist, famous for the discovery of the tomb of Tutankhamun, is buried in Putney Vale cemetery.
