1. Make all Vikings board the longboat

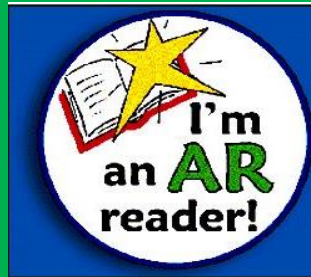
