Please Note:

- Every child must wear a school sweatshirt.
- Parents are expected to ensure children wear school shoes to school every day.
- Trainers will only be allowed to be worn during PE lessons and/or at break times.
- Children are expected to bring coats when the weather is cold, wet or changeable.
- Nail polish will be removed by an adult using nail polish remover if worn for school.
- We recommend using <https://www.mynametags.com/> to label clothes. Sadly the lost property bin frequently overflows and parents end up having to buy new uniform, because their child's name label has faded. Second hand uniform is available to purchase cheaply at school events.
